

RESOLUTION 2025-946a

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF CERTAIN UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES IN COFFEY COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Coffey County, Kansas, (hereinafter "the Board") is the governing Body of Coffey County, KS (hereinafter "the County"), and is charged with the responsibility for traffic control on all County roads; and

WHEREAS, the Road and Bridge Superintendent is authorized to make recommendations additional signage from previous resolution relative to certain traffic control devices by Resolution 2025-946, dated April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Road and Bridge Superintendent has determined the Traffic Control Plan for the 58 Hwy Bridge Replacement, would enhance public safety to establish Maximum speed limits at various locations as shown in the Traffic Control Plan for the 58 Hwy Bridge Replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it advisable and in the best interest of the citizens of the County to accept the recommendations contained within the Traffic Control Plan for the 58 Hwy Bridge Replacement Project related to that portion of the County within the 58 Hwy Bridge Replacement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COFFEY COUNTY, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:




2. That this resolution shall become effective from and after its passage by the Board of County Commissioners, Coffey County, Kansas.






